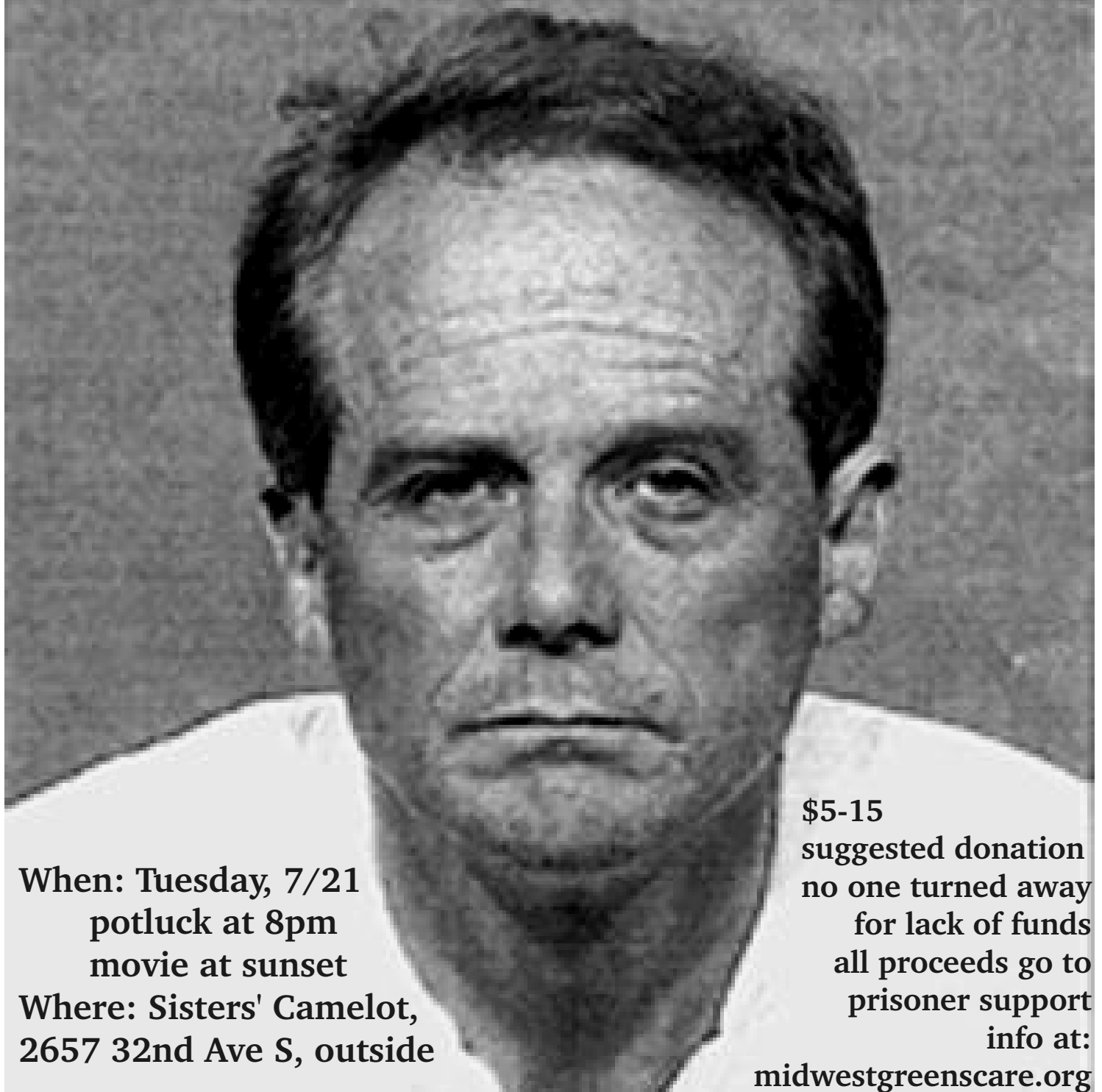


Mark Warren Sands is not your typical 'eco terrorist'.

Starting in April of 2000, he went on the attack against residential sprawl, burning down eight homes in an effort to save the Phoenix Mountain Preserves. He wrote communiques to the media under the banner, "Coalition to Save the Preserves," claiming responsibility for the actions.
